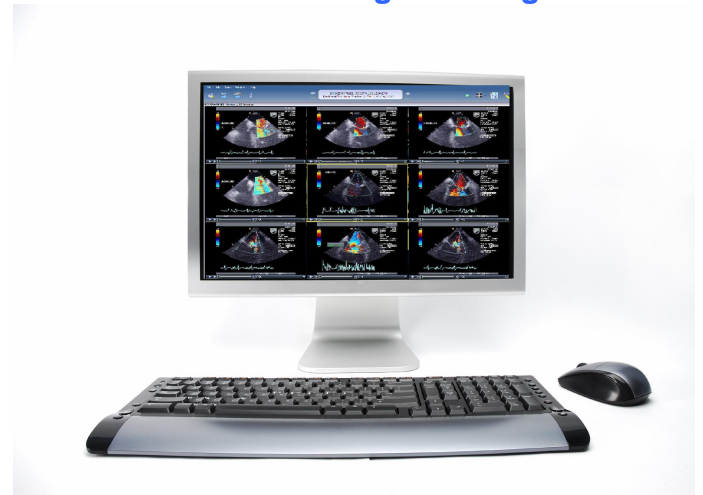
You can add a **ShowCase Connect** option to either ShowCase viewer to get DICOM network connectivity:

- Query/Retrieve qualified DICOM servers for studies

- Store images transferred over a DICOM network from ultrasound machines to disk (DICOM Store SCP).

- Download a DICOM Conformance Statement from www.TrilTech.com.

ShowCase software runs on desktop or laptop PCs with Windows® XP or Windows Vista operating systems. Recommended minimum of 2 GB RAM, 2 GB free disk space, diagnostic quality display.



ShowCase Premier Viewer features

Measurement Tools: *distance, area (elliptical and free form ROI), ultrasound Spectral Doppler and M Mode line tools.*

CD burning integrated with XP/Vista CD Burn Wizard, AND add an embedded ShowCase Onboard viewer.

Viewer Features in Both Basic and Premier

Display DICOM images from DICOM CD/DVD/disk directories or individual DICOM files

Structured Report Displays: *displays measurements and calculations sent from ultrasound machines; displays Basic Text DICOM Structured Reports.*

Crop images; margin clips

User selectable sizes; compare modes.

Multi-frame image "play" and "step" modes with speed control for "play"

Contrast / gamma adjustment

Export images in bmp, tiff, jpeg, avi formats

Remove patient identifying information for research, presentations and teaching files

Save As and Copy to DICOM media

Print reference images to desktop printer

Annotations and erase image areas

Instant export images onto PowerPoint® slides in DICOM format or in AVI, JPG, BMP or TIFF formats

Play DICOM clips directly in PowerPoint slides on PCs that have ShowCase installed
